



Thank you for considering The Watson Hall Montessori (WHM) School for your child's education. Our admission process serves several important purposes.

- 1) The process is a learning opportunity for families who may not be familiar with the Montessori method of teaching.
- 2) The process provides parents with an overview of the program. We want parents to make an informed decision regarding the suitability of the program for their child.
- 3) The process provides WHM with the opportunity to learn about your expectations and goals for your child's education. In addition, WHM is able to convey the program's expectation of children and families enrolled at The Watson Hall Montessori School.

The admission process consists of the following components:

- ❖ **Tour** – A tour will give you an opportunity to observe our classrooms, see our facility and have questions answered about our program. Please note that tours and observation sessions are for **parents only**. We request all prospective parents to tour our facility.
- ❖ **Application** – A completed Application for Admission and a **non-refundable \$75.00 application fee** are required for each family seeking student admission. A completed application for admission may be submitted after you have toured the school. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
- ❖ **Student Visit**– Upon receipt of your completed application, the Watson Hall Montessori School will schedule a visit for your child. Students will be assessed in the areas of academic skills, independence, concentration, language skills, physical development, behavior, and readiness for our program. The visit familiarizes the child with the school and establishes a mutual understanding of Montessori concepts between the family and school. Children seeking enrollment in our Lower/Upper Elementary program may be asked to visit multiple times.
- ❖ **Admission Decisions** – You will be notified of the admission decision via email. Upon acceptance of admission, parents are required to sign an enrollment contract. Enrollment contracts are offered on a space-available basis.

The Watson Hall Montessori School is coeducational and accepts qualified students regardless of race, color, religion, or ethnic origin. A student shall be 5 years of age on or before September 1st of a school year to enter the Kindergarten program during that school year. Parents may submit written request to enroll their child in Kindergarten at 4.5 years of age. This early enrollment will require testing and a conference with the child's Lead Teacher and the Administrative Head. Generally, priority consideration for enrollment is given to applicants in the following order: (1) qualified siblings of current WHM students; (2) qualified students with previous Montessori experience; (3) all other qualified applicants.
